



## **DFG Funding Opportunities for international collaboration**Initiation, networking and 1:1 collaboration

#### **Initiation Grants**

- First step, mobility funds
- Guest visits and stays abroad
- Funding for 1 year

## **Scientific Networks**

- 10-20 PIs
- To promote multi-year scientific exchange and cooperation
- Funding for up to 3 years
- International Pl´s can be included

#### **Research Project**

- One specific basic research project
- Funding for up to 3 years
- International collaborators shall bring in own funds (Calls with Indian Funders currently planned)

- 6-9 medium-term projects with a common thematic approach
- Funding for up to 6 years
- International collaborators usually bring in own funds








## International Research Training Groups

- focused research programme and a structured training strategy
- Funding for up to 9 years
- International co-PIs have to bring in own funds (through own institution or funding agency)


## **Collaborative Research Centers**

- long-term universitybased research institutions, multidisciplinary research programme
- Funding for up to 12 years
