

Alexander von Humboldt (1769 – 1859): explorer, universal genius, cosmopolitan and sponsor of excellent scientific talent


1953: Establishment of today's Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, based in Bonn Bad-Godesberg

International network of academic cooperation, modelled on Humboldt




WHAT WE DO

- We support people, not projects













The Worldwide Humboldt Network





Our Network in Southeast Asia






Humboldtians based in Sout East Asia: 332



worldwide, all disciplines, no quotas

Georg Forster Research Fellowship

- researchers from emerging and developing countries, all disciplines, no quotas
- research projects with relevance to development




Humboldt Research Fellowship / Georg Forster Research Fellowship

	Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
Duration of sponsorship	• 6 to 24 months	• 6 to 18 months, may be divided up into 3 stays
Application period	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 4 years ago 	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 12 years ago
Fellowship amount	• €2,670 per month (plus additional benefits)	• €3,170 per month (plus additional benefits)







Application Requirements


Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
above average doctorate	 independent academic activity, e.g. as an assistant professor
academic publications	 comprehensive list of academic publications with own, clearly defined academic profile
 agreement by academic host 	 agreement by academic host
 independent research proposal 	 independent research proposal
knowledge of German and/or English	 knowledge of German and/or English




International Climate Protection Fellowships

for prospective leaders and postdocs from non-European transition and developing countries, who...

- have a Bachelor's or equivalent academic degree
- have a clearly visible leadership potential
- ➤ have theme-related work experience or a successfully completed doctorate in climate protection or climate-related resource conservation
- > are engaged in climate protection or resource conservation
- > are working in non-governmental organisations, public administrations, politics, academia or business;
- would like to conduct an independent project agreed with a host in Germany
