

- › Implementation of a bioeconomy only in a global context
- › Many initiatives and funding possibilities exist for European consortia
- › Creation of this BMBF funding instrument in 2012
- › Aim: to fund German partners in collaboration with international partners
(= beyond Europe)



BIOECONOMY INTERNATIONAL


- › R&D projects to relevant subjects in bioeconomy
- › Composition of consortia is entirely flexible:
University, Research Organizations, Industry
- › At least one German partner +
one international partner (whole world)
- › Projects at eye level
- › International partners have to bring own funds
- › Exception: bilateral modules



BILATERAL MODULES

- › Collaboration with the whole world is not possible!
- › Since 2014: 1-2 bilateral modules with single countries as examples:
 - › Parallel announcement of the calls
 - › Agreed timeline
 - › Parallel evaluation process
 - › Joint selection meeting
 - › **Parallel funding of project partners**
- › In 2014, 2016 and 2019 bilateral modules with Vietnam

- › 8 calls completed (9th call in evaluation)
- › 736 proposals submitted
- › 125 projects funded
(20 partner countries) –
- › Total funding: around 74 Mio.€
- › 17 projects with Vietnam –
 - › 4 projects of 2014-joint call
 - › 3 projects of 2016-joint call
 - › 2 projects of 2019-joint call
 - › 8 projects funding only by BMBF



4TH BILATERAL CALL BMBF-MOST

- › Another bilateral call in Bioeconomy is planned
- › The launch of the call is envisaged for Q4 2023
- › Topics will be defined by MOST and BMBF based on the results of the workshop
